- (1) By Certificate of Referral dated 21st November, 2018 the Minister referred the subject dispute to the Industrial Tribunal; and
- (2) In accordance with Rule 3 (1) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules, 2010 a Notice for an Originating Application – Form A was sent on 7th January, 2019 by the Secretary, to the Tribunal, to the Applicant; and

- (6) Pursuant to Rule 15(1) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules 2010, the Industrial Tribunal set a fixture for the Case Management Hearing for Directions on the 2nd April, 2019; and
- (7) That the Applicant filed into the Tribunal a signed Notice of Withdrawal - Form K on 23rd April, 2019; and

THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL IS AS AGREED AND THEREFORE IT IS SO ORDERED:

- (8) Trade Dispute referred to the Industrial Tribunal on 21st January, 2019 is decided accordingly pursuant to Rule 12(1)(a) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedures) Rule 2010 and is hereby withdrawn and marked Dismissed.
