ORDER

WHEREAS:

- 1) This matter was listed for a Case Management hearing set for 29th April 2019 by way of Form J and on 9th April 2019 Notice of the hearing was served on both the Applicant and Respondent;
- 2) By reason that:
 - (a) The Applicant indicated that she recently lost the representation of her legal counsel of record;

- (b) Appearing for herself, the Applicant demonstrated familiarity with only one of her two pleaded claims sufficient to articulate the same to the Tribunal;
- (c) The Respondent raised jurisdictional issues on which the Applicant would require legal advice;
- (d) The Tribunal ascertained that the parties had thus far not achieved settlement of either of the claims advanced by the Applicant;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The matter is adjourned sine die in order to give the Applicant an opportunity to retain legal counsel and for the parties to attempt a settlement of the claim or any part thereof which may be capable of settlement.
2. The parties shall contact the Tribunal in order to report on the progress of matters set out in paragraph 1 of this Order for the purposes of proceeding with case management should the matter remain unresolved.
