ORDER ON DIRECTIONS

WHEREAS:

- 1) By Certificate of Referral of a Trade Dispute dated 27th February 2019, the Minister referred the subject dispute to the Industrial Tribunal;

- 2) Pursuant to Rule 3(1) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules, 2010 a Notice for presentation of an Originating Application was issued by the Secretary of the Industrial Tribunal to the Applicant on 26th March 2019;
- 3) The Applicant filed an Originating Application (Form A) in the Industrial Tribunal on 17th May 2019;
- 4) Pursuant to Rule 4 of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules, 2010 a Notice of the Originating Application (Form C) was issued by the Tribunal to the Respondent on 21st May 2019;
- 5) A Notice of Appearance (Form D) was entered by the Respondent on 14th June 2019;
- 6) This matter was listed for a Case Management hearing set for 29th October 2019 by way of Form J which was served on the parties.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The Respondents shall file their Defence and serve the same on the Applicant on or before Tuesday 19th November 2019;
2. The Applicant shall file her Bundle of Documents, if any, in support of her claim and serve the same on the Respondents by no later than Tuesday 19th November 2019;
3. The Respondents shall file their witness statement(s) and supporting documents and shall serve the same on the Applicant by no later than Tuesday 17th December 2019;
4. Each party shall be at liberty to call up to two (2) witnesses;
5. The Applicant and the Respondents, respectively, shall file and serve their skeleton arguments and authorities by no later than Wednesday 15th January 2020; and

6. The parties shall have liberty to apply for further directions and/or to vary these directions.
