WHEREAS:

- (1) By Certificate of Referral dated 25th October, 2019 the Minister referred the subject dispute to the Industrial Tribunal; and


- (2) In accordance with Rule 3 (1) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules, 2010 a Notice for an Originating Application – Form A was sent on 5th December, 2019 by the Secretary, to the Tribunal, to the Applicant; and
- (3) Upon receipt by the Applicant of the Notice for an Originating Application the Applicant filed an Originating Application in the Tribunal on the 7th January, 2020; and
- (4) A Notice of Application to the Respondent – Form C and a Notice of Appearance - Form D was sent to the Respondent on the 13th January, 2020; and
- (5) That a Notice of Appearance - Form D was filed on 17th February, 2020 and a Defence – Form E was filed in the Tribunal on the 27th February, 2020 by the Respondent; and
- (6) Pursuant to Rule 15(1) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules 2010, the Industrial Tribunal set a fixture on the 13th August, 2020 for the Case Management Hearing for Directions; and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by consent of the parties:

- a. That the Applicant will file Skeletons, Witness Statements and Submissions on or before 30th October, 2020.
- b. That the Respondent will file Skeletons, Witness Statements and Submissions on or before 6th November, 2020
- c. That the parties agreed to an estimated one (1) day of hearing.
- d. That the parties agreed that the Applicant will call two (2) witnesses and the Respondent will call two (2) witnesses.
- e. That the parties will continue to have settlement discussions and if an agreement is met they will inform the Tribunal of same.
