ORDER ON DIRECTIONS

WHEREAS:

- 1) By Certificate of Referral of a Trade Dispute dated 20 January 2020, the Minister referred the subject dispute to the Industrial Tribunal;
- 2) Pursuant to Rule 3(1) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules, 2010 a Notice for presentation of an Originating Application was issued by the Secretary of the Industrial Tribunal to the Applicant on 11 February 2020;
- 3) The Applicant filed an Originating Application (Form A) in the Industrial Tribunal on 4 March 2020;
- 4) Pursuant to Rule 4 of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules, 2010 a Notice of the Originating Application (Form C) was issued by the Tribunal to the Respondent on 12 March 2020;

- 5) A Notice of Appearance (Form D) was entered by the Respondent on 24 June 2020 and a Defence (Form E) filed on 27 July 2020; and
- 6) This matter was listed for a Case Management hearing on 3 September 2020.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The Applicant shall file Witness Statements, Bundle of Documents and Skeleton Arguments and serve the same on the Respondent by no later than Thursday 24 September 2020;
2. The Respondent shall file Witness Statements, Bundle of Documents and Skeleton Arguments and serve the same on the Applicant by no later than Thursday 15 October 2020;
3. Each party shall be at liberty to call up to two (2) witnesses at the trial of this matter and the trial shall be set down for one (1) day; and
4. The parties shall have liberty to apply for further directions and/or to vary these directions.
