ORDER ON DIRECTIONS

WHEREAS:

- 1) By Certificate of Referral of a Trade Dispute dated 22 January 2020, the Minister referred the subject dispute to the Industrial Tribunal
- 2) Pursuant to Rule 3(1) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules, 2010 a Notice for presentation of an Originating Application was issued by the Secretary of the Industrial Tribunal to the Applicant on 11 February 2020
- 3) The Applicant filed an Originating Application (Form A) in the Industrial Tribunal on 21 February 2020
- 4) Pursuant to Rule 4 of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules, 2010 a Notice of the Originating Application (Form C) was issued by the Tribunal to the Respondent on 24 February 2020

- 5) A Notice of Appearance (Form D) was entered by the Respondent on 11 March 2020
- 6) A Defence (Form E) has not been filed and the Respondent has requested an extension of time within which to file the same
- 7) This matter was listed for a Case Management hearing on 3 September 2020.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The Respondent shall have an extension of time and permission to file a Defence and serve the same on the Applicant on or before Monday 14 September 2020;
2. The Applicant shall file Witness Statements, a Bundle of Documents and Skeleton Arguments in support of her case and serve the same on the Respondent by no later than Thursday 1 October 2020;
3. The Respondent shall file Witness Statements, a Bundle of Documents and Skeleton Arguments in support of its case and serve the same on the Applicant by no later than Thursday 22 October 2020;
4. Each party shall be at liberty to call up to three (3) witnesses at the trial of this matter and the trial shall be set down for two (2) days; and
5. The parties shall have liberty to apply for further directions and/or to vary these directions.
