2. The Applicant filed in the Industrial Tribunal an Originating Application (Form A) on the 15th July, 2019; and

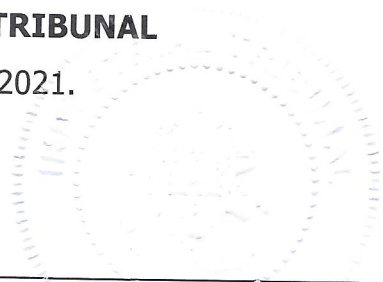
