WHEREAS:

- (1) By Certificate of Referral dated January 28, 2021 the Minister referred the subject dispute to the Industrial Tribunal; and
- (2) In accordance with Rule 3 (1) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules, 2010 a Notice for an Originating Application – Form A was sent on February 15, 2021 by the Secretary, to the Tribunal, to the Applicant; and
- (3) Upon receipt by the Applicant of the Notice for an Originating Application the Applicant filed an Originating Application in the Tribunal on February 18, 2021; and
- (4) A Notice of Application to the Respondent – Form C and a Notice of Appearance - Form D was sent to the Respondent on February 24, 2021; and
- (5) That a Notice of Appearance - Form D was filed on March 3, 2021 and a Defence – Form E was filed on May 19, 2021 in the Tribunal by the Respondent; and
- (6) Pursuant to Rule 15(1) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules 2010, the Industrial Tribunal set a fixture on July 19, 2021 for the Case Management Hearing for Directions; and

- g. That the parties will not have further settlement discussions.
