ORDER ON SETTLEMENT

The case management hearing for this dispute proceeded before the Tribunal on 22 March 2021. Following this hearing and prior to the scheduling of the matter for trial, the parties achieved a settlement of the dispute.

The parties have now presented the Tribunal with the evidence that the settlement has been fully achieved and executed. The papers evidence that the parties fully and finally settled the action on the terms embodied in a Deed of Release and Settlement executed on 21 June 2021 for the sum of Eleven Thousand Four Hundred and Ninety-six dollars and Twenty-six cents in the currency of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas (B\$11,496.26) paid by the Respondent to the Applicant.

In light of the foregoing, and pursuant to Section 58(1)(d) of the Industrial Relations Act, the Tribunal refrains from any further hearing or determination of the dispute brought by the Originating Application (Form A) filed on 6 January 2021, the same being settled and fully disposed of.
