ORDER ON SETTLEMENT

WHEREAS:

The trial of the above referenced matter was set to take place on Thursday 16 September 2021. On that day, the Tribunal facilitated the parties in discussions about their respective positions and the parties sought an adjournment to consider a settlement. The process resulted in an agreement of terms to amicably resolve the dispute.

The parties have indicated to the Tribunal that they fully and finally settled the action on 22 September 2021 for the sum of One Thousand One Hundred dollars in the currency of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas (B\$1,100.00) paid by the Respondent to the Applicant, and on the withdrawal of the dispute by the Applicant, which was effected on 4 October 2021.

NOW IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

In light of the foregoing, and pursuant to Section 58(1)(d) of the Industrial Relations Act, and Rule 12(1)(a) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules 2010, the Tribunal refrains from any further hearing or determination of the dispute brought by the Originating Application (Form A) filed on 8 January 2021, the same having been fully disposed of.
