ORDER

On Withdrawal of Action

WHEREAS:

- 1) This matter was commenced in the Industrial Tribunal by an Originating Summons (Form A) filed by the Applicant on 7 January 2020, in answer to which, on 6 March 2020, a Defence (Form E) was filed by the Respondent.
- 2) The case management hearing in this action took place on 23 July 2020 before the Industrial Tribunal, Court #3. The parties' compliance with the directions

handed down for case management was interrupted, through the fault of no party, by Covid-19 pandemic lockdowns, and directions had to be updated and ordered afresh.

- 3) The trial of this trade dispute was set and adjourned. The Applicant indicated that an attempt was being made to settle the matter. Following this, the Applicant's representative indicated that the Applicant was desirous of withdrawing the trade dispute.
- 4) On 20 April 2022, the Applicant withdrew the trade dispute by filing a Notice of Withdrawal (Form K).

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that in light of the foregoing, and pursuant to Rule 12(1)(a) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules 2010, the Originating Application stands dismissed.
