**WHEREAS:**

- 1) This matter was commenced in the Industrial Tribunal by an Originating Summons (Form A) filed by the Applicant on 26 January 2021. No Defence (Form E) was filed by the Respondent.

- 2) The case management hearing in this action took place on 17 November 2021 before the Industrial Tribunal, Court #3. The parties did not comply with the directions handed down for case management.
- 3) The trial of this trade dispute was set to take place on this 17 May 2022. Counsel for the Applicant has indicated that the Applicant is desirous of withdrawing the trade dispute. Further on 17 November 2022, the Applicant filed a Notice of Withdrawal (Form K).
