ORDER ON SETTLEMENT

WHEREAS:

- 1) This matter was listed for a Case Management hearing on 19 May 2022, and during that hearing the Tribunal heard the positions of each party in the dispute. The Tribunal then encouraged both parties to engage in a discussion to see whether a settlement was possible, given the likely merits and application of the law in the case.
- 2) The parties entered into settlement discussions and achieved a resolution of the dispute on confidential terms. Pursuant to the developments, the Applicant filed a Notice of Withdrawal (Form K) on 30 May 2022.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

In light of the settlement of this trade dispute amongst the parties and pursuant to powers under Rule 12(1)(a) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules 2010 and Section 58(1)(d) of the Industrial Relations Act, the Tribunal shall refrain from further adjudication of this trade dispute and pronounces that the matter is disposed of fully and finally.
