ORDER ON DIRECTIONS

WHEREAS:

- 1) By Certificate of Referral of a Trade Dispute dated 14 February 2022, the Minister referred the subject dispute to the Industrial Tribunal;
- 2) Pursuant to Rule 3(1) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules, 2010 a Notice for presentation of an Originating Application was issued by the Secretary of the Industrial Tribunal to the Applicant on 22 March 2022;
- 3) The Applicant filed an Originating Application (Form A) in the Industrial Tribunal on 28 March 2022;

- 4) Pursuant to Rule 4 of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules, 2010 a Notice of the Originating Application (Form C) was issued on 31 March 2022 by the Tribunal to the Respondent;
- 5) The Respondent filed a Notice of Appearance (Form D) on 12 April 2022 and a Defence (Form E) on 28 April 2022;
- 6) This matter was listed for a Case Management hearing on 9 June 2022, notice of which (by Form J) was served on the Applicant and on the Respondent.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

Filing

1. The parties shall file all documents referred to in paragraphs 2, 3 and 4 of this Order with the Tribunal electronically and shall furnish the Tribunal with physical copies for the assigned judge who will hear the trial and/or any interlocutory applications;
2. The Applicant shall file his Witness Statement(s) and Bundle of Documents and serve them on the Respondent on or before Thursday 23 June 2022;
3. The Respondent shall file its Witness Statement(s) and Bundle of Documents and serve them on the Applicant on or before Thursday 7 July 2022;
4. The parties shall file and exchange with each other their respective opening Skeleton Arguments by no later than Thursday 21 July 2022;

5. Each party shall be at liberty to call up to two (2) witnesses at the trial of this matter;

Liberty to Apply

6. The parties shall have liberty to apply for further directions and/or to vary these directions.
