ORDER

WHEREAS:

1. By Certificate of Referral dated August 24th, 2010 the Minister referred the subject dispute to the Industrial Tribunal; and –

3. Action No. IT/NES/1507/10 was gazetted in the Bahamas Journal and the Nassau Guardian on the 14th and 19th days of April 2016 in a list of call over matters.
