AND WHEREAS the Applicant failed to file a **Form A** (Originating Application) within the 14 days limited for so doing by **Rule 3(1) of The Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules, 2010**;

AND WHEREAS, by a **Notice Call Over** published in The Nassau Guardian and The Tribune Newspaper, Friday, 15th October, 2021, Edition, the parties were notified that this matter was set for hearing before the Tribunal at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, 26th November, 2021;

AND WHEREAS neither the Applicant nor the Respondent appeared before the Tribunal on Friday, 26th November, 2021;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT this matter be dismissed pursuant to **Section 58(1)(d)** of **The Industrial Relations Act**, Chapter 321 as it appears that further proceedings are unnecessary or undesirable in the public interest.
