**AND WHEREAS** the Respondent's Counsel filed 2 Witness Statements on the 12<sup>th</sup> October, 2021;

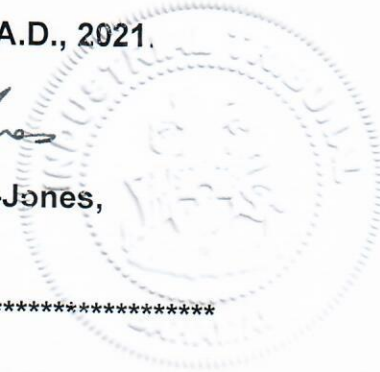
