AND WHEREAS the Tribunal conducted a **Case Management** hearing of this matter on Thursday, the 25th November, 2021, and made an **Order On Directions** pursuant to **Rule 15(1)** of the Rules;

AND WHEREAS the parties today advised the Tribunal that they resolved this matter out of Court;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT this application be dismissed pursuant to **Section 58(1)(d)** of **The Industrial Relations Act**, Chapter 321, as it appears that further proceedings are unnecessary or undesirable in the public interest.
