WHEREAS:

- 1) On the 17th April 2023, the parties appeared for Hearing, and having entered into dialogue pursuant to Section 60 of the Industrial Relations Act, the parties were able to reach amicable conclusion by means of mediation;
- 2) Accordingly, and without any admission of liability, the parties having agreed that the Respondent shall pay to the Applicant the sum of Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$14,500.00), payable in two installments, the first, in the sum of Seven Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$7,250.00) being paid on or before 28th April 2023 and the remaining balance of Seven Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$7,250.00) to be paid on or before 15th June 2023 in full and final settlement of this matter;
- 3) The Applicant, in accepting the terms of settlement in the sum of Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$14,500.00), has submitted the FORM K, and as a result thereof, and accepts and agrees that the Respondent is herewith now and forever **RELEASED** from any and all claims arising from her employment and separation therefrom whatsoever and howsoever arising, and herewith confirms, to remove all doubt, that there remains no matter outstanding between the parties.
- 4) Accordingly, this matter now stands dismissed, by way of this **ORDER OF SETTLEMENT**.
