WHEREAS:

1. By Certificate of Referral dated the 15th March, 2022, the Minister referred the subject Trade Dispute to the Industrial Tribunal; and
2. That on the 5th June, 2023, the matter was fixed by the Tribunal for Trial; and
3. Pursuant to Section 58(1) (a) of the Industrial Relations Act, Chapter 321, Statute Laws of The Bahamas, the Tribunal facilitated the parties in discussions with a view of settlement. The process resulted in an agreement of the terms to amicably resolve the dispute; and
4. The parties have indicated to the Tribunal by a Deed of Compromise and Release that they have fully and finally settled the action on the 5th June, 2023 for the sum of **Two Thousand Dollars (B\$2,000.00)** to be paid by the Respondent to the Applicant on the withdrawal of the dispute by the Applicant which was effected on the 21st June, 2023.
5. The Applicant filed a Notice of Withdrawal (Form K) on the 21th June 2023; and;

NOW IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

In light of the foregoing, and pursuant to Section 58(1) (d) of the Industrial Relations Act, and Rule 12(1)(a) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules 2010, the Tribunal refrains from any further hearing or determination of the dispute brought by the Originating Application (Form A) filed on the 5th May, 2022 the same having been fully disposed of.
