WHEREAS:

1. By Certificate of Referral dated October 5, 2018, the Minister referred the subject Trade Dispute to the Industrial Tribunal; and
2. That on June 1, 2023, the matter was fixed by the Tribunal for Mention; and
3. Pursuant to Section 58(1)(a) of the Industrial Relations Act, Chapter 321, Statute Laws of The Bahamas, the Tribunal facilitated the parties in discussions with a view of settlement. The process resulted in an agreement of the terms to amicably resolve the dispute; and
4. The parties have indicated to the Tribunal by a Deed of Compromise and Release that they have fully and finally settled the action on June 6, 2023 for the sum of **Five Thousand Nine-Hundred Seventy-Eight Dollars and Thirty-Seven Cents (B\$5,978.37)** to be paid by the Respondent to the Applicant on the withdrawal of the dispute by the Applicant which was effected on June 8, 2023.

NOW IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

In light of the foregoing, and pursuant to Section 58(1)(d) of the Industrial Relations Act, and Rule 12(1)(a) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules 2010, the Tribunal refrains from any further hearing or determination of the dispute brought by the Originating Application (Form A) filed on November 6, 2018, the same having been fully disposed of.
