#### WHEREAS:

- 1) By Certificate of Referral dated 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2023, the Minister referred the subject dispute to the Industrial Tribunal; and
- 2) In accordance with Rule 3(1) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules, 2010 a Notice for the Originating Application Form A was sent on 27<sup>th</sup> March 2023 by Her Honour, President Indira Demeritte Francis, to the Applicant; and
- 3) Upon receipt by the Applicant of the Notice for an Originating Application, the Applicant filed an Originating Application in the Tribunal on 4<sup>th</sup> April 2023; and
- 4) A copy of the Notice of Originating Application, Form C, and a Notice of Appearance, Form D, was issued to the Respondent on 6<sup>th</sup> April, 2023.
- Pursuant to Rule 15 (1) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules 2010, the Industrial Tribunal, by way of Form J dated 14<sup>th</sup> July 2023, set a fixture for a Case Management Hearing for today's date; and

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, BY CONSENT, as follows:

- 1. The Fourth Respondent Leron Williams is removed as a named party herein.
- 2. The Tribunal shall serve the Forms C, D and E to the First and Second and Third Respondents named herein, on or before 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2023;
- The named Respondents are to submit and upload the requisite Forms above mentioned to the Tribunal on or before 25<sup>th</sup> August 2023;
- 4. The matter shall be set for mention on 31st August 2023 at 10 am to determine the status of the matter herein.
- 5. The Applicant and the Respondents may call up to two witnesses each at the trial hereof.

- 6. The Applicant shall file his Witness Statements and Skeleton Arguments no later than **4:00 p.m.** on **8**<sup>th</sup> **September 2023** and the Respondent shall file its Witness Statements and Skeleton Arguments no later than **4:00 p.m.** on **22**<sup>nd</sup> **September, 2023** and, upon filing, the Applicant and the Respondent shall provide a hard copy of each to the Secretary to Court No. 5 and a copy of which shall be retained for the Court's use. Should the parties have their witnesses appear in person, a second hard copy of all documents to be relied upon at the hearing hereof, shall be presented to the secretary to Court No. 5.
- 7. The witness statements shall stand as evidence in chief at the trial and should any witness not attend, the witness statements will not be accepted as evidence.
