IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, BY CONSENT, as follows:

1. The trial of this matter shall be set down for **two (2) days**;
2. The Applicant has indicated that he intends to call up to two witnesses and the Respondent has indicated that it intends to call up to four witnesses.
 - 2.1 There shall be an inspection of documents at a place and time to be agreed between the parties on or before **12th September 2023**.
 - 2.2 The Applicant shall file her Witness Statements and Skeleton Arguments no later than **4:00 p.m.** on **20th December 2023** and the Respondent shall file its Witness Statements and Skeleton Arguments no later than **4:00 p.m.** on **11th January 2024** and, upon filing, the Applicant and the Respondent shall provide a hard copy of each to the Secretary to Court No. 5 and a copy of which shall be retained for the Court's use. Should the parties have their witnesses appear in person, a second hard copy of all documents to be relied upon at the hearing hereof, shall be presented to the secretary to Court No. 5.
 - 2.3 The witness statements shall stand as evidence in chief at the trial and should any witness not attend, the witness statements will not be accepted as evidence.
3. The Applicant and the Respondent shall file an agreed Bundle of Documents with two copies to the secretary to Court No. 5 of the Tribunal no later than **4:00 p.m.** on **27th January 2024**.
4. The hearing of this matter set for the **5th and 6th February 2024** for trial **2024**.
