- On the 18th May, 2022, Dwight Ferguson III filed a Report of a Trade Dispute against Advanced Control and Equipment Company (Bahamas) Limited with The Department of Labour in Grand Bahama, The Bahamas, which stated, inter alia, that the issues relevant to the dispute were Vacation pay and Salary owed;
