Should the parties have their witnesses appear in person, a second hard copy of all documents to be relied upon at the hearing hereof, shall be presented to the Secretary to Court No. 5.

- 3.1The Witness Statements shall stand as evidence in chief at the trial and should any witness not attend, the witness statements will not be accepted as evidence.
