WHEREAS:


1. By Certificate of Referral dated 25 April, 2023 the Minister referred the subject Trade Dispute to the Industrial Tribunal; and
2. The Applicant, pursuant to the Order made on 14 November, 2023, filed an Originating Application (Form A); and
3. The matter was listed for Call Over appearing in the Nassau Guardian newspaper on 5 March, 2024 and pursuant to the Notice of Hearing (Form J) for Case Management issued on 26 February, 2024; and
4. Pursuant to Rule 15 (1) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules 2010, the Industrial Tribunal conducted a Case Management Hearing on the 11 April, 2024; and
5. The Respondent, filed its Notice of Appearance (Form D) and Defence (Form E) filed on 29 April, 2024; and
6. The Parties appeared on 2 May, 2024 for mention and/or directions for Trial in light of the referral to engage in negotiations for pursuant to section 60 of the Industrial Relations Act; and
7. At the hearing and consequent to the discussions held and, upon taking instructions and advice, the Claimant's representative duly advised of the Claimant's intention to withdraw the claim; and

8. On 3 May, 2024 the Claimant laid over a Notice of Withdrawal (Form K) thereby withdrawing the Originating Application herein;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Originating Application filed herein on 14 November, 2023 be and is hereby deemed dismissed, pursuant to Rule 12(1) (a) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules.
