WHEREAS:

- 1. By Certificate of Referral dated 23rd February 2023, the Minister referred the subject Trade Dispute to the Industrial Tribunal;
- 2. The Applicant filed in the Industrial Tribunal an Originating Application (Form A) on the 24th March 2023; and
- 3. Pursuant to Rule 15 (1) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules 2010, the Industrial Tribunal conducted a Case Management Hearing for directions today, on the 30th April 2024;
- 4. Whereupon, the parties having appeared, entered into dialogue pursuant to Section 60 of the Industrial Relations Act, and were able to reach amicable conclusion by means of mediation;

WHEREAS:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, BY CONSENT, as follows:

- 1. The trial of this matter shall be set down for 2 days;
- 2. The Applicant has indicated that he intends to call up to 2 witnesses and the Respondent has indicated that it intends to call up to 3 witnesses.
 - 2.1 There shall be an inspection of documents at a place and time to be agreed between the parties on or before 17th May 2024.
 - 2.2 The Applicant shall file its Witness Statements and Skeleton Arguments no later than **4:00 p.m.** on 31st May **2024** and the Respondent shall file its Witness Statements and Skeleton Arguments no later than **4:00 p.m.** on **14th June 2024** and, upon filing, the Applicant and the Respondent shall provide a hard copy of each to the Secretary to Court No. 5 and a copy of which shall be retained for the Court's use. Should the parties have their witnesses appear in person, a second hard copy

- of all documents to be relied upon at the hearing hereof, shall be presented to the secretary to Court No. 5.
- 2.3 The witness statements shall stand as evidence in chief at the trial and should any witness not attend, the witness statements will not be accepted as evidence.
- 3. The Applicant and the Respondent shall file an agreed Bundle of Documents with two copies to the secretary to Court No. 3 of the Tribunal no later than **4:00 p.m.** on 28th June **2024**.
- 4. This matter is set for mention for Friday 17th May 2024.
