- On the 27th March, 2023, Sharise Tate Ferguson ("the Applicant") filed a Report of a Trade Dispute against Ampsec International Ltd. ("the Respondent") with The Department of Labour in Grand Bahama, The Bahamas, which stated, inter alia, that <u>the issues relevant to the dispute</u> were Wages owed for Supervisor's position, Constructive Wrongful Dismissal (Notice pay, Severance pay) and Constructive Unfair Dismissal;
