- 2. The trial of this matter shall be set down for 3 days;
- 3. The Applicant has indicated his intention to call up to two witnesses and the first Respondent has indicated that it intends to call one witness and the Second Respondent has indicated that it will call up to three witnesses.
- 4 The Applicant shall file his Witness Statements and Skeleton Arguments no later than 4:00 p.m. on 16th of August 2024 and the First and Second Respondents shall file their respective Witness Statements and Skeleton Arguments no later than 4:00 p.m. on 30th August 2024 and, upon filing, the Applicant and the Respondent shall provide a hard copy of each to the Secretary to Court No. 5 and a copy of which shall be retained for the Court's use. Should the parties have their witnesses appear in person, a

second hard copy of all documents to be relied upon at the hearing hereof, shall be presented to the secretary to Court No. 5.

- 5 The witness statements shall stand as evidence in chief at the trial and should any witness not attend, the witness statements will not be accepted as evidence.
- 6. The date of hearing of this matter shall be determined by the Registry.
