WHEREAS:

- 1. By Certificate of Referral dated 13^{TH} November 2019, the Minister referred the subject Trade Dispute to the Industrial Tribunal; and
- 2. The Applicants respectively filed in the Industrial Tribunal their individual Originating Applications (Form A) on the 20th of July 2023; and
- The Tribunal being advised of the demise of Applicant Jaden Goodman, who is withdrawn from the matter as per the communication of Advocate Errol McKinney;
- The Respondent has not entered the Form D nor the Form C; which was accompanied with the Notice of Originating Application dated 23rd April 2021,
- 5. And, notwithstanding a series of call overs, which were duly published for which the Respondent has failed to attend;
- 6. Pursuant to Rule 15 (1) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules 2010, the Industrial Tribunal conducted a Case Management Hearing for directions today, on the 5th of July 2024, and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, as follows:

- 1. The Respondent shall file its Form D and its Form E within 14 days hereof, i.e., on or before 22nd July 2024.
- 2. The trial of this matter shall be set down for 3 days;
- 3. The Applicants have indicated that they intend to call up to FOUR witnesses. There is no indication from the Respondent as to the witnesses it will call.
- 4. Inspection of documents, if required, shall take place on or before 26th July 2024 with an agreed bundle of documents to be presented on or before 2nd August 2024.
 - 4.1 The Applicants shall file their Witness Statements and Skeleton Arguments no later than **4:00 p.m.** on 16th of August 2024 and the Respondent shall file

its Witness Statements and Skeleton Arguments no later than **4:00 p.m.** on 30th August 2024 and, upon filing, the Applicant and the Respondent shall provide a hard copy of each to the Secretary to Court No. 5 and a copy of which shall be retained for the Court's use. Should the parties have their witnesses appear in person, a second hard copy of all documents to be relied upon at the hearing hereof, shall be presented to the secretary to Court No. 5.

- 4.2 The witness statements shall stand as evidence in chief at the trial and should any witness not attend, the witness statements will not be accepted as evidence.
- 5. The date of the hearing of this matter shall be determined by the Registry.
