#### WHEREAS:

- On the 4<sup>th</sup> October, 2023, a Report of a Trade Dispute was filed on behalf of Brian Collie, Cleon Newton & Roscoe Burrows ("the Applicants") against Commonwealth Electrical Workers Union ("the Respondent") at The Department of Labour in Grand Bahama, The Bahamas;
- 2) It stated, inter alia, that the issue relevant to the dispute was *Breach of the Union Constitution and Bye-laws, Section #22-C of the Constitution, #33 and Articke 24-4 of the Industrial Agreement*;
- 3) By a **Certificate of Referral** dated the 18<sup>th</sup> January, 2024 (received on the 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2024), the Honourable Minister of Labour & The Public Service referred the said trade dispute to the Industrial Tribunal, Northern Region, ("the Tribunal");
- 4) In accordance with **Rule 3(1)** of **The Industrial Relations** (**Tribunal Procedure**) **Rules**, **2010** ("**The Rules**"), on the 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2024, the Tribunal served the **Applicants** (received by *Cleon Newton*) with notice of the referral;
- 5) The Applicants filed a **Form A** (Originating Application) on the 7<sup>th</sup> March, 2024;
- 6) On the 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2024, the Tribunal served a copy of the **Form A** (Originating Application), a **Form C** (Notice of Originating Application) and a **Form D** (Notice of Appearance) on the Respondent (received by *Edrondo Thompson*);
- 7) The **Respondent** filed a **Form D** (Notice of Appearance) on the 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2024 and a **Form E** (Defence) on the 2<sup>nd</sup> April, 2024;
- 8) The Tribunal conducted a Case Management hearing today;
- 9) The Tribunal directed that **Applicant Roscoe Burrows** appear before the Tribunal on the adjourned date in person if he is unable to get the microphone to work when appearing virtually (via the ZOOM platform);
- 10) Pursuant to **Rule 9** of **The Rules**, the Tribunal directed that the Respondent's Counsel submit his preliminary objections to the Applicants' entitlement to bring these proceedings against the Respondent, in writing, to the Tribunal and the 3 Applicants;
- 11) The Tribunal directed that the **3 Applicants** respond to the said preliminary objections, in writing, to the Tribunal and the Respondent's Counsel;

- 12) The **Tribunal** acceded to the parties' request to fast-track the hearing of the matter and abridge the 14 days' notice of the hearing required by **Rule 8(1)** of **The Rules**;
- 13)The Tribunal directed that the **Applicants** e-mail the Tribunal Clerk and the Respondent's Counsel:-
  - all amendments to the Respondent's Constitution; and
  - the Industrial Agreement referred to in The Report of a Trade Dispute; and
- 14)Pursuant to **Section 58(1)(a)** of **The Industrial Relations Act, Cap. 321**, the Tribunal remitted the trade dispute to the parties for further consideration, with a view to settling/reducing the issues in dispute;

### IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:-

- 1. The matter is adjourned to **10:00 a.m.** on **Tuesday, 23<sup>rd</sup> April, 2024**, for full hearing;
- 2. The **Respondent's Counsel** submit his preliminary objections to the Applicants' entitlement to bring these proceedings against the Respondent, in writing, to the Tribunal and the 3 Applicants;
- 3. The **3 Applicants** respond to the said preliminary objections, in writing, to the Tribunal and the Respondent's Counsel; and
- 4. The **Applicants** e-mail the Tribunal Clerk and the Respondent's Counsel:-
  - all amendments to the Respondent's Constitution; and
  - the Industrial Agreement referred to in The Report of a Trade Dispute.
