WHEREAS:

- 1) On the 3rd August, 2023, **Nastacia Grant** ("the Applicant") filed a **Report of a Trade Dispute** against **Jarol Investments (Chances)** at **The Department of Labour** ("DOL") in Grand Bahama, The Bahamas, which stated, inter alia, that the issue relevant to the dispute was *Wrongful Dismissal*;
- 2) By a **Certificate of Referral** dated the 13th September, 2023 (received on the 6th November, 2023), the Honourable Minister of Labour & The Public Service referred the trade dispute between the Applicant and **Jarol Investments** ("the Respondent") to the Industrial Tribunal, Northern Region, ("the Tribunal");
- 3) On the 12th February, 2024, the Tribunal conducted a **Case Management hearing** in this matter and made an **Order On Directions**;
- 4) Pursuant to **Section 59(1)(b)(ii)** of **The Industrial Relations Act** and **Rule 16(1)** and **(2)** of **The Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules, 2010** ("The Rules"), on the 11th March, 2024, the Tribunal joined **JAROL INVESTMENTS LIMITED** as the Respondent and dismissed **JAROL INVESTMENTS** from the proceedings;
- 5) The matter was set for **trial** on the 19th June, 2024; and
- 6) On the 10th April, 2024, the **Applicant** filed a **Form K** (Notice of Withdrawal) in this matter;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT this matter be dismissed pursuant to **Rule 12(1)(a)** of **The Rules**.
