WHEREAS:

- On the 15th January, 2024, Glenneisha Reckley ("the Applicant") filed a Report of a Trade Dispute against Better Care Janitorial and Lawn with The Department of Labour in Grand Bahama, The Bahamas, which stated, inter alia, that the issues relevant to the dispute were 2 weeks' Wages owed/and Redundancy pay or Notice and Severance pay;
- 2) By a Certificate of Referral dated the 9th April, 2024 (received on the 30th April, 2024), the Honourable Minister of Labour and The Public Service referred the trade dispute between the Applicant and Better Care Janitorial and Lawn Maintenance Service Company Ltd. ("the Respondent") to the Industrial Tribunal, Northern Region ("the Tribunal");
- 3) In accordance with **Rule 3(1)** of **The Industrial Relations** (**Tribunal Procedure**) **Rules**, **2010** ("**The Rules**"), on the 1st May, 2024, the Tribunal served the **Applicant** with notice of the referral;
- 4) The Applicant filed a Form A (Originating Application) on the 2nd May, 2024;
- 5) On the 3rd May, 2024, the Tribunal served a copy of the **Form A** (Originating Application), a **Form C** (Notice of Originating Application) and a blank **Form D** (Notice of Appearance) on the Respondent (received by *Belinda Jones*);
- 6) The Respondent failed to file a **Form D** (Notice of Appearance) within the 7 days limited for so doing by **Rule 5(1)** of **The Rules** (by the 10th May, 2024);
- 7) On the 10th May, 2024, the Tribunal served a letter enclosing a blank **Form E** (Defence) on the Respondent (received by *Belinda Jones*);
- 8) The Respondent failed to file a **Form E** (Defence) within the 14 days limited for so doing by **Rule 6** of **The Rules** (by the 24th May, 2024);
- 9) On the 27th May,2024, the Tribunal issued a **Form J** (Notice of Hearing) setting this matter for Case Management at 10:00 a.m. today (Friday, 21st June, 2024), which was personally served on the parties on the 28th May, 2024 (Respondent's copy received by *Belinda Jones*);
- 10) The Tribunal stood the matter down until 3:00 p.m. today (Friday, 21st June, 2024) as Acting President Helen J. Almorales-Jones was attending the funeral of the late *K.C. Thomas Evans* (the spouse of *Acting Tribunal Vice-President Carolyn Vogt-Evans*) at 11:00 a.m. today;

- 11) The Respondent's President, *Llewellyn Jones*, advised the Tribunal Clerk, by telephone, that he was unable to appear at 3:00 p.m. today;
- 12)Only the **Applicant** appeared, in person;
- 13)Pursuant to **Section 59(1)(a)** of **The I.R.A.**, the Tribunal proceeded with the Case Management hearing under **Rule 15** of **The Rules**;
- 14) Acting President Helen J. Almorales-Jones appeared virtually (via ZOOM);
- 15) The **Applicant** advised that she alone will testify on her behalf at the trial;
- 16) The **Tribunal** estimated that the trial may last 1 day;
- 17) The **Tribunal** directed that the parties produce the original (if available) and 3 copies of all documents upon which they intend to rely at the trial; and
- 18) **Rule 3(6)** of **The Rules** provides that the parties are at liberty to file **Written Representations** in this matter with the Tribunal at least 7 days prior to the commencement of the hearing;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:-

- 1. This matter is adjourned **10:00 a.m.** on **Friday, the 26th July, 2024**, for trial;
- 2. The parties produce the original (if available) and 3 copies of **all documents** upon which they intend to rely at the trial;
- 3. The parties file any **Written Representations** by on or before **3:00 p.m.** on **Friday, the 19th July, 2024**, and at the same time serve a copy thereof on the opposing side; and
- 4. The Tribunal serve this **Order On Directions** and a **Form J** (Notice of Hearing) for trial on both parties.
