**WHEREAS:**

1. By Certificate of Referral dated 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2024 the Minister referred the subject Trade Dispute to the Industrial Tribunal; and
2. The Applicant filed in the Industrial Tribunal an Originating Application ( Form A) on the 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2024 and;
3. Pursuant to Section 58(1) (a) of the Industrial Relations Act, Chapter 321, Statute Laws of The Bahamas, the Tribunal facilitated the parties in discussions with a view of settlement. The process resulted in an agreement of the terms to amicably resolve the dispute; and
4. The Applicant has indicated to the Tribunal by a Form K the withdrawal of the dispute, which was effected on the 27<sup>th</sup> May, 2025.
