TRY TO SETTLE MATTER...

WHEREAS:

2. The parties attended for continuation of trial hearing today Wednesday 25th June 2025, the Applicant, represented by Advocate Tyrone Morris, entered into dialogue with the Respondent's Attorney, Valentino Hamilton; and were able to reach amicable conclusion to this matter by means of mediation;
3. Accordingly, and without any admission of liability, the parties have agreed that the Respondent, **TOP NOTCH CATERING**, shall pay to the Applicant, **LATOYA PINDER**, the sum of Two Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00), in full and final settlement of this matter to be paid in monthly installments of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) beginning July 30th 2025, by way of bank transfer;
4. The Applicant, in accepting the terms of settlement in the sum of Two Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00), has submitted the **FORM K**, and as a result thereof, accepts and agrees that the Respondent is herewith now and forever **RELEASED** from any and all claims arising from her employment and separation therefrom whatsoever and howsoever arising, and herewith confirms, to remove all doubt, that there remains no further matter outstanding between the parties, as touching the instant action;
5. The parties further agree to retain full confidentiality with the terms of this Settlement and shall altogether resist and forbear from disparaging comments made with respect to each other;
6. Accordingly, this matter now stands dismissed, by way of this **ORDER OF SETTLEMENT**.
